Flood Threat Tonight through Saturday

Weather Synopsis

The National Weather Service (NWS) in Wilmington has issued a **Flood Watch** from 8:00 PM tonight through 2:00 PM Saturday, March 25. Overall, expecting 2.00 – 2.5” of rain for our area; isolated higher amounts are possible.

Multiple rounds of moderate-to-heavy rain is expected tonight through Saturday. The heaviest precipitation is anticipated Friday night into Saturday morning. The rain showers should start to taper off late Saturday morning. Gusty conditions are forecasted by Saturday afternoon with sustained southwest winds of 20-30 MPH with gusts up to 50 MPH.

Threats

Excessive runoff may result in flooding of rivers, creeks, streams, and other low-lying and flood-prone locations. In addition, flash flooding is possible with heavy rainfall.
