NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2 FOR FUNDING UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FLEXIBLE GRANT PROGRAM

The County of Shelby intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Flexible Grant Program, a federally funded program administered by the State. The County is eligible for fiscal year 2023 CDBG funding, provided that the County meets applicable program requirements.

The application is due to ODOD by April 30, 2024.

A second public hearing will be held **Thursday**, **July 27th**, **2023 at 9:00 a.m.** at the Shelby County Commissioners' Office to give citizens an adequate opportunity to review and comment on the proposed CDBG application, including the proposed activities as summarized above, before the County submits the application to the Ohio Department of Development.
