Dear Russia Community,

With spring approaching, we're thrilled to share the progress on the Russia Pavilion and Splash Pad! The pavilion is under roof and construction is moving swiftly. We anticipate its completion in early Summer this year. While the reservation process is still being evaluated, we'll provide more information in the coming months.

As for the splash pad, the plumbing is in place. We'll wait for nicer weather before resuming construction. The splash pad is also expected to be completed by early Summer.

From the project's onset, we sought funding from surrounding businesses and organizations. We've been successful in these efforts, along with securing a generous \$500,000 grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Despite the incredible support, we still face a funding gap.

To address this shortfall and in response to community interest in contributing financially, we're launching a 30-day fundraising drive. For the next month, any individual, family, business, or organization that donates \$1,000 or more will be recognized with a permanent inscription on a commemorative plaque.
